Iranian Student Memorial Scholarship

The University of Toronto has established the Iranian Student Memorial Scholarship Fund in honour of those who lost their lives in the crash of Ukrainian International Airlines Flight PS752, including eight members of the University of Toronto community.

The Iranian Student Memorial Scholarship will provide needs-based award(s) to international students from Iran (admitted to the U of T) or current U of T students, from any background, studying Iranian studies. The first of these needs-based awards were awarded in Spring 2020 for students studying at U of T in the 2020-21 academic year.

Students must be admitted to U of T in an undergraduate or graduate program before they can apply for the award.

Scholarship Application Deadline: **November 30, 2023 5pm** Value: To be determined based on the income generated from the endowment Results: Scholarship recipient(s) will be notified in January 2024.
